This year 2023, *Le Temps Retrouvé* offers you to discover during a 4-days academy an exceptional collection of viennese fortepianos from 1786 to 1830, in their music *salon* in Villeneuve-lez-Avignon (South France). During these days centered around Schubert, you will be part of private and collective classes lead by Alain Roudier, pianofortist et organologist.

This academy welcomes harpichordists, pianists and organist, and propose to practice all different keyboards, and to learn and understand the connections between the instruments - which are not as hermetic as what modern practice may suggest. To rediscover your own versatility in front of different keyboards, to develop your ability to adapt both technically and musically, to explore an underrated musical and instrumental world : these are the objectives of the academy.

Your days will be divided between individual lessons, collective classes and personal practice. A concert will be played by the students, for the students, at the end of the academy - not to forget a good dosis of relaxation and fun by the swimming pool !

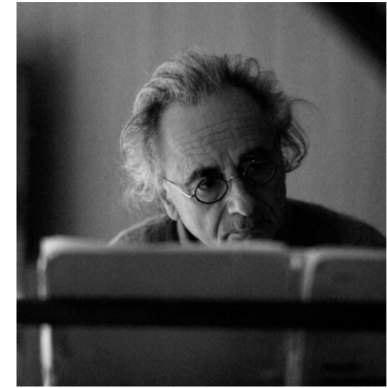

After studying in Paris with Alain Planès, Alain Roudier was a student of Menahem Pressler in Bloomington, USA. Organologist, researcher and performer, he gathered a collection of 20 historical instruments and played them in concert in most of Europe and beyond. He also appeared as a lecturer on the evolution of keyboard manufacture, and is author or co-author of numerous books and articles. In 2004 he was awarded the Mazzotti Prize for his work.
